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<b><u>Instrument Reference Data</u></b>	<b><u>Standards to be used for information population</u></b>
<b>Instrument ISIN</b>	ISO 6166
<b>Market where the instrument is admitted to trading</b>	ISO 10383 (4 character SWIFT MIC)
<b>Instrument Name</b>	e.g. XYZ plc Ord Lm 0.25
<b>Underlying Instrument Identification</b>	ISO 6166  Mandatory if the instrument is a derivative instrument
<b>Instrument Type</b>	ISO 10962 (full 6 character CFI Code)
<b>Maturity Date/ Exercise Date/ Delivery Date</b>	ISO 8601  Mandatory if the instrument is a debt or derivative instrument
<b>Strike Price</b>	A numeric field, up to 19 characters. The price should be expressed in the major currency i.e. Euros rather than Euro cents.  Mandatory if the instrument is a derivative instrument
<b>Strike Price Currency Code</b>	ISO 4217  Mandatory if the instrument is a derivative instrument

<b><u>Instrument Reference Data</u></b>	<b><u>Standards to be used for information population</u></b>
<b>Price Multiplier</b>	A numeric field, up to 19 characters.  Mandatory if the instrument is a derivative instrument
<b>Nominal Value</b>	A numeric field, up to 19 characters indicating the face value of the debt instrument.  Mandatory if the instrument is a debt instrument
<b>Date of Admittance to Trading</b>	ISO 8601
<b>Country of Registered Office</b>	ISO 3166  Mandatory if the instrument is a debt or money market instrument
<b>Country of Index</b>	ISO 3166  Mandatory if the instrument is an index derivative instrument
