

Insurance Rule 9 of 2007

Repeal of Insurance Directive 9 of 1999 - Commercial Business Which May be Stated in the Objects of Companies Acting as Insurance Agents

Rule pursuant to article 4 of the Act

1. (1) This Insurance Rule repealing Insurance Directive 9 of 1999 - Commercial Business Which May be Stated in the Objects of Companies Acting as Insurance Agents (“this Rule”) is made by the Authority pursuant to, and for the purposes of, article 4 of the Act.

(2) This Rule shall come into force on the 1st March 2007.

Repeals and Savings

2. (1) Saving the provisions of paragraph (2) of this article, Insurance Directive 9 of 1999 - Commercial Business Which May be Stated in the Objects of Companies Acting as Insurance Agents, is hereby repealed.

(2) Every action, directive, instruction, guideline or order whatsoever taken or commenced thereunder, shall continue to be valid and in force, as if such action, directive, instruction, guideline or order were taken or commenced under Insurance Intermediaries Rule 11 of 2007 - Commercial Business Which May be Carried out by Enrolled Persons.
