European Single Electronic Format (ESEF)

Background

ESMA has today published the <u>Final Report</u> on the RTS on the European Single Electronic Format (ESEF) which included the RTS and also the Field Test Report. It was approved by the Board of Supervisors on Thursday 14 December and submitted to the European Commission on Friday 15 December.

This is an important step forward to bring financial reporting in Europe into the digital age.

To facilitate implementation of ESEF and to inform the market the following several other materials were published today as well:

- i. The ESEF Reporting Manual that contains further guidance for issuers and software companies.
