ESMA publishes first Q&As in relation to the new Prospectus Regulation

Background

The European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) has, on Wednesday 27th March 2019, published a new <u>Questions and Answers Document</u> on the implementation of the new <u>EU Prospectus Regulation</u> (EU) 2017/1129.

The Q&As provide information on the following issues pertaining to the Prospectus Regulation:

- 1. The scope of the grandfathering of prospectuses approved by Member States implementing the Prospectus Directive;
- 2. The status of level 3 guidance following the transition from the Prospectus Directive to Prospectus Regulation; and
- 3. The process of updating information in a Registration Document or Universal Registration Document.

The purpose of the Q&As is to promote consistent supervisory approaches in the application of the Prospectus Regulation, as well as to provide direction on how national competent authorities are to interpret the Prospectus Regulation.
